Dear Medical Trust Participants,

While open enrollment is a passive enrollment period (meaning you will automatically be re-enrolled if you do not make any changes), there are a few important changes that will be occurring and are important for you to know.

I have highlighted all the changes in the attachment titled "2025 Benefit Changes", but the most important change to be aware of is the new healthcare navigator, Quantum Health. Beginning on January 1, 2025, Quantum will be your direct contact for all your health benefit questions. They will be able to assist with:

- Find in-network physicians
- Answer claims, billing, and benefits questions
- Prepare for a hospital stay
- Verify coverage and, if necessary, get prior approval
- Contact doctors to coordinate treatment
- Save on out-of-pocket costs
- Replace ID cards, and more

In December 2024, enrolled members will receive new ID Cards with a NEW plan number, which you MUST use for medical, behavioral health (including the EAP), and prescription (Express Scripts) services. Your old cards will not work after 12/31/2024.

The new cards will also include the phone number for Quantum Health, 1-866-871-0629, available M-F 8:30 am to 10 pm. All questions regarding your benefits should be directed through Quantum Health, not Anthem BCBS beginning January 1, 2025.

Below you will find additional important details about our 2025 health benefits offerings and the Annual Enrollment process. Please share this information with your eligible employees and treasurers.

Our online Annual Enrollment for 2025 will run from October 16 – November 15, 2024.

We encourage you to explore the plans offered and to go online during the Annual Enrollment to check your information, including name, address, dependents, plan selections, etc. Below are the medical and dental plans we offer through The Episcopal Church Medical Trust:

The primary plan for the Diocese of Bethlehem will remain the *Anthem BCBS BlueCard PPO 90.* This plan will be fully covered by the employer for full time employees or as according to your agreement.

If you choose the *Anthem BCBS BlueCard PPO 100* plan, your contribution will be the amount above the cost to the employer for the primary plan for the Diocese of Bethlehem as shown below:

What You Need to Know About Annual Enrollment

During the Medical Trust's Annual Enrollment period:

- Current plan members may change their plan selections for 2025.
- Eligible non-participating employees have the option to enroll in a Medical Trust plan.
- Eligible dependents may be added or removed from a member's plan without the need to demonstrate a qualifying event.
